2021 KCGI International Student Tuition Support Scholarship Program

The objective of the Kyoto College of Graduate Studies for Informatics (KCGI) Scholarship Program is to support the development of future highly-qualified professionals capable of pursuing information technology and business innovation to contribute to the international community. The KCGI Scholarship Program is intended for privately-funded international students with excellent academic record seeking admission to the graduate program and who are in need of tuition support. Prospective international students need to check the tuition waiver schedule below to determine their eligibility status before applying. (only for Kyoto Main Campus students)

Special Class (S-C)	Tuition fees for the First Year: JPY 890,000 Second Year: JPY 890,000	Students of universities engaged in KCG/KCGI joint programs or sister-school status.
Class 1 (C-1)	Tuition fees for the First Year: JPY 1,020,000 Second Year: JPY 1,070,000	Students nominated or recommended by company or university attended.
Class 2 (C-2)	Tuition fees for the First Year: JPY 1,190,000 Second Year: JPY 1,240,000	All applicants

XStudents who have applied for this scholarship can take a limited number of credits.

1. Application Procedure and Requirements

The application process is composed of two stages: document/test evaluation and oral interview. The initial evaluation of the applicant's eligibility status for the tuition waiver will be based on the following documents:

- 1 KCGI Scholarship Application Form
- ② Certification of graduation issued by the relevant academic institution.
- 3 A certified copy of academic transcript issued by the relevant academic institution.
- ④ A recommendation letter from an academic advisor/professor or a supervisor/manager from a workplace (use the format specified by KCGI)
- (5) Japanese language or English language proficiency test results (copy). (such as Japanese Language Proficiency Level N2 Exam score; EJU score above 225; J.Test score above Level C; BJT score above 400; Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL IBT above 80; IELTS score above 5.5, or equivalent)
- **(6)** Financial support-related documents (ex. Income Statement for the past 3 years)
- ⑦ Other additional documents for reference (optional): Reference documents for evaluation purpose. *Not necessary to submit with the required documents for admission but may be helpful.

2. Interview Schedule

As a rule, the qualifying test for the KCGI scholarship is conducted on the same day together with the KCGI admissions examination. Successful applicants who pass the document/test stage will be duly notified of the interview schedule.
